## **MOSL**

K-2nd grade: 3 days to administer

\*MOSL score is a part of the teacher's score at the end of the year.

## **Rigorous Instruction**

### **Reading**

3rd grade students are grouped based on their present reading levels. Students visit different classroom teachers to better meet their literacy needs. Groups will change. Student needs are being targeted and growth is being tracked.

### **Math**

Our school has a new curriculum. Two teachers are math leads: Ms.Carrasco & Mr.Levine. They meet at the district office and turnkey information they have learned. As a school, teachers have met this week as grade cohorts to plan their upcoming math unit.

Math intervisitations- teachers will visit each other's classrooms to observe best practices.

## **Computer Based exams.**

State exam for 5th grade (science, ela and math) will be computer based. We had received practice on how students will take this exam to help reduce the learning curve of a computer based exam. Ms.Felipe-Rossi & Ms.Almonte will collaborate.

### **3K & PK**

Our school is in a partnership with PS 106, PS 299 and PS 75 to plan collaboratively. They will have opportunities to visit each other's schools as well as virtually. Teachers will collaborate and innovate together. This is an initiative from PS 116.

### **Supportive Environment**

-Our school would like to collaborate with PS 106 to strengthen our student council.

-Special education- Ms.Acosta goes to workshops about special education and will turn key information to teachers. We would like to meet on the 3rd or 4th Friday of the month so Ms.Acosta can turnkey information about special education.

-Hip-Hop Dance- A dance program for 2nd and 3rd grade is coming to our school.

-Our Saturday program is currently only for grades 3rd-5th. The lessons will teach our students leadership skills and entrepreneurship. We would like to have a showcase so students can share with their families about what the program means to them. This showcase will be a great opportunity for lower grade parents to see what they can expect if their child attends the Saturday program when they are in the upper grades. One of the goals is for the students to do something for the community.

-Math after school program will begin in November on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. We are focusing on math because we have a new math curriculum. We do not want to create gaps in their math learning while learning this new math curriculum. We are also using iReady to build upon their math learning. Teachers had a meeting with iReady and closely examined BOY diagnostic data to see what prerequisite learning the students need. In the after school program, students will be grouped based on their math needs. We are also using the previous math state exam to guide which students need to attend this after school program.

SBST- will create a quarterly news letter.

School Website- Ms.Allauzen will add our SLT notes to our school website.

-Parent teacher conferences are virtual. As a school, we will do one link, with different breakout sessions for different classrooms.

### **Special trip to Aladdin on 10/25/23**
