Recap - Ms.Rossi-Felipe

Dr.Lozada (superintendent) visited recently and was happy with what she saw in the classrooms she visited.

Ms.Felipe shared presentation about instructional shifts we have been making in our curriculums in regards to HMH Into Reading & Arriba la Lectura. We asked for support from the D32 team.

-Used Anita Archer for explicit vocabulary instruction, use HMH across all days, collaborative discussion routines, vocab routine for the daily lesson is 10-12 minutes. Vocabulary is also memorialized on charts.

We will continue tracking through formative and summative assessments. Students should be engaged in the vocabulary and connect to different content areas, reading, and writing.

Rigorous Instruction

We would like a K-2 and 3-5 meeting for parents regarding illustrative math because it is a new curriculum.
